The Declaration of Independence and your God Given rights!

THE NEED

The litany of problems with the American culture, economy and political system are manifest and widely acknowledged. There may be some debate as to which problems are most fundamental and dangerous to the USA, but who really believes that the current systems of values and government can survive for even another 25 years? How many Americans really believe our nation's best years aren't all behind us? How many doubt that our future will be characterized by lower standards of living, less freedom and greater government regulation, taxes and oppression?

Globalism:

Without constitutional authority, our national government has decided to subject the American people to a "New World Order" of global government. The government originally dedicated to "securing" each man's God-given, unalienable Rights, is now dedicated to expanding the powers and profits of multi-national corporations.



As a result, the majority of Americans are threatened by lost jobs, lost industries and lost unions while a handful of corporate elitists gain previously unimagined wealth.

Fascism:

When President Eisenhower left office in A.D. 1961, he warned Americans of the growing "military-industrial complex"--an association between government and corporations. Since then, that political association between government and corporations has grown to not only threaten American freedoms but even resemble fascism. Overseas, we seem to be almost endlessly engaged in one minor war after another.

Police State:

At home, we are subject to the highest incarceration rate in the world--higher than that of the former "evil empire" Soviet Union and higher than that of Red China. Some estimate that the incarceration rate within the USA is seven to nine times higher than the average for the rest of the world. By this measure, "We the People" have become less free under a government that can be reasonably described as the world's biggest police state.

Unlimited taxation:

Our formerly limited government is now virtually unlimited. Our tax average tax burden has grown from roughly 15% of our gross income in A.D. 1950 to over 55% today. At the same time that our tax burden has grown, our national debt has soared. We have degenerated from the world's wealthiest nation in A.D. 1950 to, today, the world's biggest debtor nation. Our currency has likewise depreciated until today's dollar is worth less than a nickel in A.D. 1933. In A.D. 1994, President Bill Clinton predicted that the next generation's total tax burden would exceed 80% of their gross income.



Political Treason:

Our two party political system has been captured by special interests which are, by definition, contrary to the rights of the people at large. The Democrats prostitute themselves to unions and big government; Republicans whore for corporations and big government. Both parties and their candidates are for sale to the highest bidder. Neither party supports the God-given, unalienable Rights of the common man.

Assault on Faith:

Most unnerving is government's persistent assault on the Christian faith and belief in the God of the Bible. Government's most dramatic denial of Godly principles is probably seen in the newly-created right of abortion where as many as 1.7 million children have been murdered in a single year. Promiscuity, sexual immorality and homosexuality have been rising, and not merely tolerated but often encouraged by government. Our two-party marriages (where one man and one woman are joined under God to become "one flesh") have been replaced by state-licensed "marriage relationships" which are three-party legal fictions consisting of a husband, a wife and the state. As a result, divorce rates have soared, families have been shattered, and children are routinely raised without fathers.

Under the pretext of "separation of church and state," our government has sought to not only separate (and protect) the state from the church, but ultimately to control and destroy the true church of God. Almost every American church is a "501(c)3" corporation chartered under the Internal Revenue Code and national government.

In return for certain tax advantages, these "501(c)3 churches" have agreed to restrict their political activities to



no more than 5% of their budgets and resources. As a result, the American churches that should be among the first to protest the loss of the "unalienable Rights" given us by God are muzzled and almost never criticize the government that has betrayed those fundamental rights.

"Esau I have hated."

Genesis 25 through 35 presents the story of Esau and Jacob--the twin sons of Isaac and Rebekah. According to the Bible, Esau and Jacob struggled with each other even while in the womb. This struggle between the unborn brothers seems based on the significance of the order of birth. As per God's law, the first-born son would receive the "birthright" and thus be entitled to inherit virtually all of the fathers land and wealth. The second-born son would be left to inherit almost nothing. Apparently, at least Jacob understood the significance of the birth order, even before he was born and therefore struggled from the moment of his conception to secure the birthright.

However, Esau was born first and even though Jacob emerged from the womb just seconds later, still clutching Esau's heel, Esau was entitled to receive the birthright, and Jacob was seemingly denied.

Years later, when Esau came home hungry and weary and asked Jacob for some lentil stew. Jacob agreed to give his brother food, if his brother would swear to give his birthright to Jacob. Esau, believing he was near death, agreed to abandon his birth right and therefore traded his birthright for a "bowl of pottage". "Thus Esau despised his birthright." Genesis 25: 34

Years later, the twins' father Isaac was blind and preparing his will and determined to give his blessing to Esau. But Jacob, guided by his mother, deceived his blind father into



giving him (rather than Esau) his paternal blessing. Esau was so angry that Jacob had once again taken one of Esau's entitlements, that he determined to kill Jacob, and therefore Jacob ran away.

Twenty-one years later, Jacob--a prosperous man--returned with wives children and livestock to his family home. Esau--also prosperous and powerful--forgave Jacob for his deceptions and the two were reconciled. "But Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck and kissed him and they wept." Genesis 33:4 Later, when their father Isaac died at age 180, "his sons Esau and Jacob buried him" (Genesis 35:29) Thus, there was no animosity between the brothers. Esau had generously forgiven Jacob's trespasses. In truth, Esau seems to be a pretty good man.

Nevertheless, later in the Bible (at Malachi 1:2-3 and Romans 9:13), God twice declares "yet I loved Jacob, and I hated Esau".

I am not a Biblical scholar, but if Esau is not unique in the Bible, he is certainly an uncommon person in that he has been expressly named as someone who provoked God's hatred. At Jeremiah 49:10 and Obadiah 1:18, God further explains his curse on Esau and we are left to wonder why God hates Esau--who, by human terms, seems to be a pretty likable guy. So how did Esau provoke God's hatred?

In Malachi 1:4-6 we begin to glimpse the cause of that hatred when God refers to Esau as having aroused His "indignation for ever" by "despis[ing] my name". How did Esau "despise" God's name?

Remember Genesis 25:34 ("Thus Esau despised his birthright.")? I believe Esau provoked God's hatred by trading his birthright to Jacob for a mere bowl of pottage. Why? Because by despising his birthright--which flowed



from a "jealous" God--Esau unwittingly despised not only the birthright but also the source of that right: God, Himself.

This interpretation is supported by Hebrews 12:14-17 which advise men to avoid emulating Esau, "who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright" and "afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, . . . was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears."

Esau provoked God's hatred "for ever" by despising his God-given birthright.

America's Divine Retribution?

If you read the three fundamental principles of the "Declaration of Independence," you'll see that The United States of America was conceived on the spiritual foundation that "all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights".

I believe these God-given, unalienable Rights attach to each man and woman at the moment of creation and are thus similar to the Old Testament "birthright" with which God endowed first-born sons. I.e., both the Old Testament birthright and the Declaration's "unalienable Rights" are the gifts of the God of the Bible. Both rights are the gifts of the jealous God of the Bible.

Today, the government of these United States no longer recognizes or performs its primary duty to secure the God-given, unalienable Rights on which this nation was conceived. Today, government's refusal to perform its primary duty is complemented and made simple by the fact that the American people neither know nor understand the source or significance of those God-given rights.



As one result, Americans have forgotten that the God-given "unalienable Right" to Life declared in the Declaration attaches to every member of our species at the moment of creation--not birth. In that ignorance, we have allowed our government to neglect its primary duty to "secure" to each member of our species his or her unalienable Right to Life. If our government had performed that primary duty, there could be no "right" of abortion in this country. Why? Because even the unborn are created by God and thus even the unborn have the God-given, unalienable Right to Life.

The alleged "right" to abortion is based on America's ignorance of God-given, unalienable Rights.

Esau was also ignorant of the significance of his God-given birthright but was nevertheless hated by God for despising that God-given right. Can the people of The United States of America expect to be held in higher esteem if they also despise their God-given, unalienable Rights--even if their rejection is unwitting and unintentional? I don't think so.

Dire spiritual jeopardy?

I believe The United States of America is in dire spiritual jeopardy. I do not know if it is already too late to turn God's wrath away; only God knows. But I believe there is still a chance that if we work to restore a government that "secures" our God-given, unalienable Rights, we might yet save this nation from the wrath that relentlessly stalks Esau and his descendants. And even if you and I can't save the USA, perhaps, by trying, some of us may yet at least help save ourselves.

America is in great jeopardy and may even be dying. Our nation's former ability to inspire ourselves and the world has been replaced by a consummate capacity to "hustle," deceive and, if need be, invade. Who can doubt that we



owe it to ourselves and our children to restore the God-based government that the Founders first envisioned? Who can deny that we owe a duty to God, Himself, to struggle to regain our God-given, unalienable Rights?

The Constitution Party

The two fundamental objectives for the Constitution Party are simple:

- 1) To restore the American people's understanding and respect for the God-given, unalienable Rights first declared in the "Declaration of Independence"; and,
- 2) To restore the "republican form of government" guaranteed at Article 4 Section 4 of The Constitution of the United States of America and thereby restore a government that performs its duty to "secure" our God-given, unalienable Rights.

The primary purpose behind these two objectives is to avoid God's wrath for despising the divine blessing of "unalienable Rights" and regain God's blessings on the men and women of The United States of America.

As you'll read, we intend to achieve all this with nothing new and nothing more than the principles and words on which this nation was first conceived over two hundred years ago. We are going back to the beginning, to the source of our former greatness--our Father YHWH, the ever-living God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel and Father of the Christ Yeshua.
